	Fort Myer Thrift Shop Spouse Scholarship Application and Agreement form. Download, print, and fill out from our website. Applicant and sponsor must sign.
	Readable photocopy, front and back, of applicant's dependent ID card. Must be a current ID card.
	Name of post-secondary institution currently attending, field of study, expected degree, or certification and date of completion. Or, it can be sent directly to the Fort Myer Thrift Shop, but postmarked no later than April 12, 2022 (if applicable.)
	Names of post-secondary institutions you have been accepted to and where you have applied. (If applicable.)
	Awards and activities. One page summary. Do not exceed one page.
	Essay. Do not exceed two pages. Refer to Fort Myer Thrift Shop Spouse Scholarship Instructions form for more information.
	One letter of recommendation. Refer to Fort Myer Thrift Shop Spouse Scholarship Instructions form for more information.
